- IRAP offers chatbots which offer information through Facebook Messenger and Telegram. To talk to the chatbot, [add @irapchatbot on Telegram](#) or [message them on Facebook](#). Then, type “hello” as your first message. The chatbot will respond to you and ask you a series of questions about your situation. If you are using Telegram, click the window button next to the text box to view which options are available to respond to a message. These options automatically appear on Facebook.
