HIAS has training materials available and can offer personalized guidance in your area. Make sure candidates running in national and local elections understand your community's deep concern for refugees. Organize, attend, and co-sponsor rallies and actions that protest violations of the rights of safety of refugees. Sign and share HIAS petitions and action alerts. Amplify the urgency of support for refugees through media and social media channels. As a synagogue, join the HIAS Welcome Campaign - a network of 450 congregations across the U.S. who are advocating for refugees, raising awareness about the crisis, and welcoming refugees locally .
